NOTES TO THE CONTRIBUTORS.

PROCEDURES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF THE WORKS.

The series Contribution to the Education and the Environmental Protection publishes original scientific papers in the topics of: Environmental Analysis, Toxic Substances Evaluation, Waste Treatment, Wastewaters Treatment, Environmental Health, Environmental Monitoring and related Methodologies, Environmental Impact, Environmental Modelling, Environmental Management, Environmental Energies and Environmental Education.

1. Types of Contribution

Articles to be published in future volumes will be accepted in the following forms: Complete Originals, Bibliographical Reviews.

2. Language

The original paper will be accepted in Spanish, they can be also accepted in English and Portuguese language.

3. Title

The title must be as concise as possible, not exceeding 45 characters, but clearly reflect the character of the work. It must be written in capital letters, in Times New Roman 12 style, centred and highlighted. Under the title must appear the full name and the address of the authors in Times New Roman 12 style. The telephone numbers, fax and e-mail addresses of the main author must be attached for the Editorial Committee mail.

4. Abstract

The Abstract must be written in Times New Roman 12 style with double spacing. Relevant information about the work must be contained within 250 words.

5. Key Words

Key Words will be indicated immediately after each Abstract. They can not exceed 5 key words, those that identify the most relevant aspects of the investigation.

6. Format of the Article

The papers are to be written with double spacing and will have a maximum of ten (20) pages, including the information tables and graphics are allowed. Margins of 2 cm are required at the top, bottom and each side. Times New Roman 12 style must be used. The subtitles will be indicated highlighted and will be justified to the left. The text must be intensively analysed before sending it to the Editorial Committee. The article should be divided as follows:

Title, Authors: Address of the institution, Abstract, Key Words, Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion, Acknowledgements (if desired), Bibliography.

7. Introduction

The introduction of the work must directly state the object of the work.

8. Illustrations and Tables

Tables

Tables and figures must not exceed a total of 10 and they should be made compact with vertical forms to the shape of the sheet. Tables must be numbered subsequently in the following way: Table 1., Table 2., Table 3., in the order mentioned in the main text, and must have titles. The text of tables must be written in Times New Roman 12 style and will be used vertical and horizontal lines to define the lines and columns. The writing must be clear and justified in the centre of the column.

Photographs

Only shiny photographs will be accepted, to permit good reproduction. The photos should accompany the original material, on sheets with clear definition of the location and number within the text, and with descriptions of the abbreviations and symbols.

Drawings and Maps

Drawings and maps lacking clarity will not be accepted. The maximum admissible size is 20 x 27 cm and the minimum is 10 x 12.5 cm. They must be accompanied by a computer diskette of the material that has been in order to achieve its reproduction in high-resolution printers

9. References

The references in the text will appear of the following way: all the references must be listed jointly at the end of the work and alphabetically organized. These should begin with the surnames of the main author followed by his/her initial name, after that the year of the publication, and after which will be written the title of the work, the name of the publication, followed by the number of the volume and the pages of the text. The books and report references must include the authors, the year of the publication, the title of the book, the publishers and the place where was published.

10. Paper Submission

The authors should submit a electronic copie by e-mail mentioned. ***The attachment of papers do not exceed 600 kb of memory.***
